



TRI-POD CHAIN VISE

Assembly Instructions:

Slide the Rear Leg Assembly through the Tray Support Ring. Insure that the Rear Leg Assembly is correctly facing away from the Tool Tray, the foot is facing outwards and that the Tool Tray could fold upwards. Tighten set screw.

Next, place the Front Leg Assembly in the Tool Tray. Check that the foot is down and facing outwards. Push Tray Pin through he holes provided in the Front Leg Assembly and the Tool Tray. Lock in place with the X Shaped Washer by tightening the pins.

Repeat the same process for the second Front Leg Assembly.

Put the Base Assembly upside-down on the floor. Insert the three legs into the slots remembering that the Rear Leg Assembly is opposite the chain and Vise Jaws. Push the Leg Bolts through the holes provided and tighten the nuts and lock washers.

Pick up Tri Pod and place right side up. Insure that the Tool Tray is firmly seated. You may adjust the correct location of the set screw for the Rear Leg Assembly.
